Fall Activities begin soon! Practices begin **Monday, August 17th** and the fall All-Sport PAC meeting is being held **August 17th at 6:00 PM** in the Mankato East Auditorium with individual team meetings to follow.

Registration is now open for Fall Activities. All registrations must be completed and paid for online. Please visit our registration site at <https://mankatoeast.affinity.com/activities/welcome> to view available activities and complete your online registration. Instructions can be found on the homepage of the registration website or by [clicking HERE](#). **Everyone will need to create a new account and link your students to your account.** To link your students, you will need their **Student Number** and their **birthdate**. Their student number can be found on the Parent Portal on the student's SUMMARY page.

All student athletes must have completed online registration and have a current MSHSL Sports Qualifying Physical Examination Medical Eligibility Form on file in the Mankato East Activities Office before participating in practices. **Physical expiration dates must EXTEND THROUGH THE SEASON in order to register for an activity.** (If your sport ends 10/31/25 and your physical expires 10/24/25, the system will not allow you to register with your current sports physical). Physicals can be emailed to Lori Allan at LALLAN1@ISD77.ORG, faxed to the Activities Office at 507-207-3798 or dropped off at Mankato East HS. Physical expiration dates are located on the student/parent portal under MORE and PROFILE INFO. **Please do not contact the Activities Office to check on physical expiration dates.** Due to Data Privacy, the Activities Office cannot share the sports physical expiration date with you. Sports physicals can be scheduled at most local clinics, some urgent care centers, and some chiropractic offices. Most local clinics have copies of the form for your use but you can also find the form here: [MSHSL Sports Qualifying Physical Form](#).

Students who qualify for **free or reduced Educational Benefits** qualify for free activity registrations. You will need to submit an application to NUTRITION SERVICES and be approved before you can begin registration. Applications must be completed annually.
